

Pathways to Work with AE

Sponsor/Collaborate on Research



Sponsor a Research Project

- Allows full contractual control, negotiated IP transfer
- Requires 66.5% overhead + direct costs



Give a gift to GT for use for a lab/professor

- Allows for reduced overhead of 5%
- Doesn't provide for contractual control over work done or IP transfer



Partner with GT on Research Projects

sponsored by an outside entity (SBIR, STTR, etc.)

- Allows for joint contractual control, possible IP transfer, no cost to partner
- Requires overhead at rate for the prime sponsor (~57-67%).



Send an Employee Back to GT to Pursue MS or PhD

- Allows for control of research topics of joint interest with GT
- Requires student to gain admission to program of interest
- PhD must be resident in Atlanta campus
- MS can be done either distance learning or residential



Employ a GT Faculty Member as a Consultant

- Faculty have complete discretion on accepting consulting work
- No GT resources may be utilized in the completion of the work (no library, experimental or computer equipment/software or IRB oversight)

Participate in GT Career Fairs

- GT Career Center hosts multiple fairs
- All-Majors Career Fair is hosted in both the fall and spring semesters.
 - Fall 2023 attendance: 8,100+ students
 - Spring 2024 attendance: 3,500+ students



Participate in AE School Career Fairs

- Hosted by the AE School in the Fall & Spring
- Over 90% of attendees are AE undergrad & graduate (MS and PhD) students.
 - Fall 2025 attendance: 671 students
 - Fall 2023 attendance: 738 students
 - Spring 2024 attendance: 286 students
